## About She Connects

Our Vision is to build a nationwide community of female leaders who support, empower, and encourage one another to pursue their dreams by creating meaningful connections through mentorship relationships. Our program is a national initiative that provides mentorship to young women in grades 10 to 12. Mentors range from 20 - 30 years old. As a fully volunteer initiative we are reaching out to the corporate, government, and non-profit sectors to support our initiative and help ensure its success.

## The Founders

Four women all under the age of 25, Avneet Sandhu, Emily Haugen, Meghan Dunn, and Leena Parhar, met at Daughters of the Vote in 2019. The founders represented their ridings in the House of Commons; Fleetwood-Port Kells (Avneet), Langley-Aldergrove (Emily), Abbotsford (Leena), and Pitt Meadows-Maple Ridge (Meghan). Using seed funding from the Rosemary Speirs Leadership Grant, the four decided to launch She Connects to fill a gap that was missing when they were in high-school: female peer mentorship. The program now has 30 mentors and is endeavouring to recruit mentees.
